

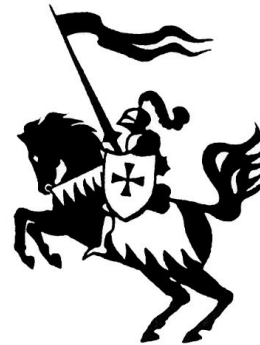

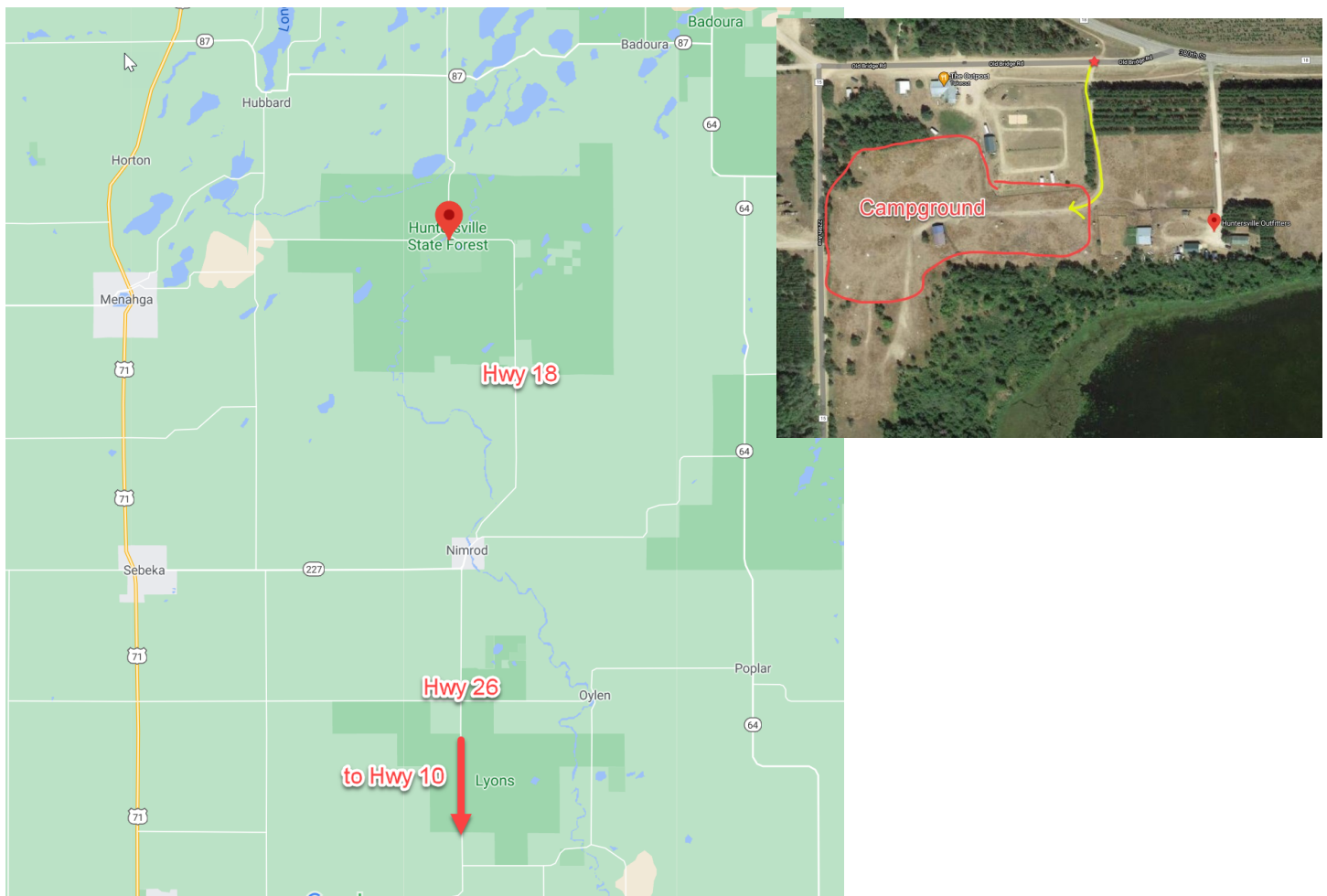

DIRECTIONS: From the south, east or west, navigate to the town of Huntersville, MN (zipcode 56464) via Huntersville Rd/18/380th. From the north, Hwy 13/25 will get you there. Follow the signs to ridecamp. For those using GPS, navigate using the address listed. Watch for ridecamp signs and TURN SLOWLY onto Old Bridge Rd!! The next turn for ridecamp comes quickly!!



TRAIL DESCRIPTION

Trails have good footing – grass, dirt, some fine gravel. Mostly two-track and single-track trails through the woods, and it's mostly flat terrain. TRAILS ARE BAREFOOT-FRIENDLY! There will be natural water and water tanks along the trail. All vet checks are in camp. This trail can handle a lot of rain, so we ride Rain or Shine!
